## Drew Eddy:

From a preparation and experience standpoint, there's really not many firms in Colorado or really any that I can think of where they have an attorney solely focusing on firearm-related issues and laws. This is all I do. I'm exclusively working in this field.

## Drew Eddy:

My name is Drew Eddy. I'm a partner here at Richards Carrington Law Firm. My specialty is a company called US Law Shield. So we contract with them. They are a national company that provides legal representation to members if they find themselves in an incident usually related to self-defense. My role with Law Shield is basically the point person for any member matters or incidents that come through. And then, depending on what the situation is, if it is covered under their membership, then we represent them.

## Drew Eddy:

I was a prosecutor for over half decade at the Denver D.A.'s Office. I would say probably 70% of my cases were weapons-related charges. So firearm, knives, self-defense situations, I prosecuted all those. And then when I came over to Richards Carrington, I am now, obviously, on the defense side. Being able to have access to an attorney to speak to and understand these laws ahead of times, especially an attorney that does this on a 24/7 basis, it probably is the most invaluable part of this, of the Law Shield Membership, that you can have. Because while you're the lawful firearm owner, you're educating yourself before an incident occurs to understand how you should react instead of just reacting based off of what you think is best. That's probably not best practice.
